

You have decided on a Vasectomy.

Our clinic offers this service, but you need to be aware of the following.

- 1. A vasectomy is a permanent contraceptive option. Although reversals are possible, the procedure is not covered by Alberta Health, and might not be successful.
- 2. Sperm banking is available in Calgary but expensive, if interested follow this link: regionalfertilityprogram.ca
- 3. A Vasectomy is not immediately effective. You will be given a package, to collect a post vasectomy semen sample at 4-6 months, and the result of this test will be communicated to you.
- 4. Risks: Failure rate of a vasectomy is 0.02%-0.2%,

Chronic testicular pain: This is a rare occurrence 1% in normal individuals, or up to 5% of individuals, with significant previous trauma/infection/pre-existing testicular pain.

Local **bleeding** and **infection** are possible complications; care will be given in the operative and postoperative period to prevent these rare complications.

- 5. A \$130.00 facility fee (non-refundable) will be charged at time of booking your procedure.
- 6. For information on preparing for the procedure follow the links on this website.
- 7. If you have significant swelling (not bruising) of the scrotum, or increasing pain/redness/discharge from the wound (signs of infection), contact the office, or proceed to Rockyview Hospital (after hours) for assessment.
